**A RESOLUTION concerning**

**COMMUNITY CENTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

FOR the purpose of establishing a Community Center Advisory Committee for the Town of Riverdale Park; and matters generally related thereto.

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:** In 2006 the Riverdale Park Town Council set aside money for two projects: an addition to the Riverdale Park Municipal Center, and seed money for a Community Center. With the addition to the Municipal Center in operation as of July of this year, the Town can now focus attention on the Community Center project. However, there are a large number of decisions that must be made before the project can move forward, including the location of the Community Center, the mix of activities that will occur at the center, other sources of funding for the center, and how the center might be operated. Because these decisions are important, the Town needs input from stakeholders both inside and outside of Riverdale Park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK** that it hereby creates an advisory committee, to be called the "Community Center Advisory Committee", which is charged with researching all topics needed to define the Community Center project. The Community Center Advisory Committee shall provide, by the end of May 2010, a report reflecting a consensus opinion on topics including but not limited to the physical location and usage of a Community Center. The chair of the committee shall be nominated by the Mayor and approved by the Town Council.

Each Town Council Representative may either serve as a committee member or appoint a representative to do so.
