An Ordinance concerning

Alarm Systems and Fees

FOR the purpose of altering certain fees for the issuance of certain alarm permits; shortening the duration of certain current and future alarm permits; correcting a certain definition; and generally relating to the regulation of alarms in the Town of Riverdale Park.

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BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments
Chapter 47 – BURGLAR AND HOLDUP ALARMS
Sections 47-1 and 47-3(f)
Code of the Town of Riverdale Park
(January 2008 Revision)

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK, That Sections 47-1 and 47-3(f) of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park (January 2008 Revision), be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 47 – BURGLAR AND HOLDUP ALARMS

§47-1. Definitions

* * *

“License or permit” means a license or permit issued to an alarm business or an alarm system user by the ~~Prince George's County Chief of police RIVERDALE PARK CHIEF OF POLICE OR~~ his/her designee.

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§47-3. Burglar and Holdup Alarm User Permits

(f) Alarm User Fees

(1) There shall be a ~~fifty~~ FORTY dollar (~~\$50.00~~40.00) non-refundable nonresidential or commercial alarm permit fee for the initial application. Said permit shall be valid for the balance of the calendar year in which the application is filed, ~~and for the following calendar year~~. Said permit shall expire on December 31 of the year after IN which application is made. Payment shall accompany the application.

(2) There shall be a non-refundable ~~biennial~~ ANNUAL nonresidential or commercial alarm renewal fee of ~~fifty~~ FORTY dollars (~~\$50.00~~40.00). The fee is due by January 15 of the following expiration of the permit. The fee may be paid by the alarm user or the alarm business. Payment shall accompany the renewal application.

(3) There shall be a ten dollar (\$10.00) fee for duplicate registration stickers.

(4) If an alarm user permit, residential or commercial, has been revoked or suspended, a non-refundable reinstatement fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) must accompany an application for reinstatement.


(5) There shall be no permit or renewal fee for a residential alarm permit. However, any application for a residential alarm permit at a site where the resident is the same and at the same site where a permit has been previously revoked or suspended, must be accompanied by the one hundred dollar (\$100.00) reinstatement fee.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all alarm user permits issued prior to the effective date of this Ordinance shall expire on December 31, 2011 and shall be subject to renewal under the terms of Article 47 of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park as amended by this Ordinance.


SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after its passage by the Council.
