

Resolution 2011-R-18

Resolution to approve a Cooperation Agreement between Prince George's County and Town of Riverdale Park regarding participation in the County's CDBG and HOME programs, and to authorize the Town Administrator to sign the necessary documents.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County is in the process of re-qualifying as an urban county to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) entitlement grant funds during Federal Fiscal Years 2012-2014 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, these grants may be used to undertake eligible community development housing and activities in municipalities that elect to enter into cooperation agreements with the County; and

WHEREAS, municipal participation with the County allows the County to include the municipality's population with that of the County's unincorporated areas, thereby increasing the County's annual entitlement; and

WHEREAS, participating municipalities may be eligible to receive project-financing assistance through the County's CDBG, and where applicable, HOME programs that will begin July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverdale Park has historically participated in the County's CDBG programs;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

The Town of Riverdale Park Mayor and Council do approve a Cooperation Agreement between Prince George's County and Town of Riverdale Park regarding participation in the County's CDBG and HOME programs and authorize the Town Administrator to sign the necessary documents.
