An Ordinance concerning

Town Employee Post-retirement Health Insurance Benefits

FOR the purpose of clarifying and modifying certain post-retirement health insurance benefits payable under a program established by the Town for certain employees of the Town of Riverdale Park; and generally relating to providing post-employment benefits for certain retirees of the Town of Riverdale Park.

Chapter 51 – PERSONNEL
ARTICLE I, Post-retirement Health Insurance Benefits
Section 51-1(c)
Code of the Town of Riverdale Park
(January 2008 Revision)

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK, That Section 51-1(c) of Code of the Town of Riverdale Park (January 2008 Revision), Chapter 51 – PERSONNEL, ARTICLE I, Post-retirement Health Insurance Benefits, be and it hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 51 – PERSONNEL

ARTICLE 1, Post-retirement Health Insurance Benefits

§51-1. Program for retiree health insurance benefits.


(c) if the Town Council appropriates sufficient funds in the Town's annual budget, and subject to the terms and conditions in this Section, the Town shall reimburse an eligible retiree IN ANY FISCAL YEAR for seventy-five percent (75%) of the amounts paid annually by the eligible retiree for health insurance premiums for coverage of the retiree and any other family members included on the retiree's health insurance plan coverage. The Town's annual reimbursement to the eligible retiree shall not exceed the amount that the Town contributes that FISCAL year towards the cost of the MINIMUM premium for individual health insurance coverage for an active Town employee.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after its passage by the Council.
