An Ordinance concerning

MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBER SALARIES

FOR the purpose of altering the annual salaries to be paid to the Mayor and Council Members for the terms of office beginning in June, 2013; providing for the payment of such salaries; providing for the effective date of this Ordinance; and matters generally related thereto.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: Sections 203 and 403 of the Riverdale Park Town Charter provide that any increases or decreases in salaries payable to Council Members and the Mayor shall be adopted by ordinance that shall be passed prior to a regular biennial Town election, and that shall take effect on the first Monday in June following that election. The Town Council desires to alter the annual salaries payable to Council Members and the Mayor commencing with the terms of office that begin on the first Monday in June, 2013.

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK, That Section 2-7 of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park (January 2008 Revision), Chapter 2 – ADMINISTRATION, be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 2 – ADMINISTRATION

§ 2-7. Compensation of elected officials.

(a) On and after June 4, ~~2007~~ 3, 2013 the Mayor shall be compensated at the rate of ~~six hundred~~ ONE THOUSAND dollars (~~\$600~~ \$1,000) per month.

(b) On and after June 4, ~~2007~~ 3, 2013, the members of the Council shall be compensated at the rate of ~~three~~ FIVE hundred dollars (~~\$300~~ \$500) per month.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become effective on June 3, 2013, the first Monday in June, 2013.
