WHEREAS, a substantial population of children between the ages of 12 and 14 residing in the Town of Riverdale Park attend William Wirt Middle School for their education; and

WHEREAS, William Wirt Middle School, a facility of the public school system of Prince George's County since 1963, has a staff dedicated to the education of the attending students as demonstrated by national awards achieved in STEM competitions; and

WHEREAS, the students and staff of William Wirt Middle School contend daily with a physical structure with substantial issues due to age which impinge upon and hamper the efforts made, both in learning and educating; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of Prince George's County along with the County Council of Prince George's County are responsible for the allocation of public funds for the improvement or construction of facilities purposed for the education of school aged children;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Riverdale Park supports the construction of a new facility to replace William Wirt Middle School, calling upon both the School Board and the County Council of Prince George's, working with the Governor's Office as well as the 22nd and 47th District Delegations to Annapolis, to identify resources and allocate funding.
