WHEREAS, the Town of Riverdale Park endeavors with the civic associations of the greater Riverdale area, the office of Prince George's County Council Member Eric Olson and the Maryland-National Capitol Park and Planning Commission towards the improvement of the section of Kenilworth Avenue between River Road to the north and Edmonston Road to the south, known as the central Kenilworth Avenue corridor; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned partners, along with the Central Kenilworth Avenue Revitalization CDC and CASA de Maryland, recognize and applaud the efforts by the Prince George's County government to affect improvements within the same area with the Transforming Neighborhoods Initiative; and

WHEREAS, through assessment and the evaluation of options to address the needs of the community, there is a general consensus of opinion among these stakeholders of the importance of and the necessity to establish a center dedicated in providing for all the opportunity towards self-advancement, enrichment and improvement; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of such a center will address a longstanding need for the community which will be in the interests of businesses, residents and workers alike and in turn can affect marked improvements in the areas of public health and public safety; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council for the Town of Riverdale Park supports a request made previously by Prince George's County District Three Council Member Eric Olson for the inclusion in the FY 2015 county budget as to be prepared by County Executive Rushern Baker III, the amounts of \$250,000.00 towards capital expenses related to the construction of and/or renovations for and \$250,000.00 towards operational and administrative expenses of such a center, located in the described corridor.
