 2. **Motion** - To substitute the amended Ordinance 2012-OR-02, an ordinance amending certain regulations relating to the issuance of parking permits, moved to adopt the amended ordinance 2012-OR-02
 3. **Motion**- To substitute the amended Emergency Ordinance 2012-OR-03, an emergency ordinance concerning dumpsters and storage receptacles on residential property. Motion to amend with the following change to section 50-16 to reduce permit fee from \$100.00 to \$25.00, Motion to postpone until special legislative meeting on April 30, 2012.
 4. **Motion**- To substitute the amended Ordinance 2012-OR-04, an ordinance concerning dumpsters and storage receptacles on public property, motion to withdraw his motion to substitute the amended Ordinance 2012-OR-04, motion to postpone until special legislative meeting on April 30, 2012.
