Legislative Action

1. Motion to support a request for a liquor license transfer for Rinaldi's Riverdale Bowl (Ward 4) and to authorize the Town to send a letter to the Board of License Commissioners indicating the need for a security plan with a State of Maryland certified sworn police officer.

Motion made by CM Lingua, second by CM Thompson
CM Lingua withdrew the motion.

Motion to take a 5 minute recess was made by CM Thompon at 10:08 p.m. with the second by CM Lingua. Vote 4-0
Session began again at 10:13 p.m.

Motion to support a request for a liquor license transfer for Rinaldi's Riverdale Bowl with the following conditions:

A Property Use Agreement (PUA) should be entered into by the Town and the applicant that includes: one State of Maryland certified sworn police officer four days a week from 7:00 p.m. until 45 minutes after last call for alcohol; part-time security may use marked vehicles; security plan must include the entire property, including the parking area; hours of operation must not increase; no public dancing; trash must be pick up in the parking area.

Motion made by CM Lingua, with the second by CM Thompson

Amendment to the motion: Should the proposed PUA not be entered into by both parties, then the motion is to take no position on the transfer request, but send a letter to the Liquor Board indicating the need for the security plan to include Maryland-certified officers.

Amendment to motion: Change "4 days a week" to Friday and Saturday and 2 more days of the operator's choosing.
