FOR THE PURPOSE of confirming the appointment of judges for the Ward 5 Special Election to be held on February 16, 2016, and setting the rate of compensation to be paid to election judges at that election.

WHEREAS, A special election will be conducted on February 16, 2016, to fill a vacancy in the office of Council member from Ward 5; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council confirmed appointments of individuals to serve as Chief Judge, Deputy Chief Judge and election judges for the regular Town election that occurred on May 4, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the individual appointed to serve as election judge upon recommendation of the Ward 5 Council member has resigned her position as an election judge; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that the special election can be efficiently and fairly conducted by existing election judges without filling the vacancy for this election; and

WHEREAS, as provided in Section 29-3(c) of the Town Code, the terms of office of election judges is two years. Thus, it is the intent of the Town Council that all other election judges appointed to serve for the May 4, 2015, regular election shall continue to serve for the February 16, 2016, special election; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-6 of the Town Code requires the Mayor and Council to establish compensation of the judges of election at the meeting when the judges are appointed; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK that the Council confirms that all election judges appointed to serve prior to the May 4, 2015, regular Town election shall serve as judges for the Special Election on February 16, 2016.


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK that election judges for the February 16, 2016, special election shall be compensated at the same rate as was paid for the May 4, 2015, regular Town election.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council.
