An Ordinance concerning

Town Charges and Fees

FOR the purpose of modifying certain existing and establishing certain additional charges and fees imposed and collected by the Town of Riverdale Park; ratifying, confirming and validating the collection of charges and fees imposed by the Town of Riverdale Park prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; providing that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable; and matters generally related to charges and fees imposed and collected by the Town of Riverdale Park.

 (as enacted by Ordinance 2011-OR-03)
 Code of the Town of Riverdale Park

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK, That Section 23-1(b), as enacted by Ordinance 2011-OR-03, Article 23 – CHARGES AND FEES, of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park (January 2008 Revision), is repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 23 – CHARGES AND FEES

§23-1. IMPOSITION OF CHARGES AND FEE.

(B) The Town may collect the following fees and charges in the amounts specified:

(2) Police Department fingerprinting - ~~\$40.~~\$59.50, EXCEPT \$39.50 WHEN PERFORMED FOR A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION.

(11) COPY OF A CD OR DVD- \$10.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Town Council hereby ratifies, confirms and validates the Town’s imposition and collection, prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, of the charges and fees set forth in Section 23-1(b) of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park as enacted by Section 1 of this Ordinance as fully as if such charges and fees had been established by ordinance at or before the time of their imposition and collection.

SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that if any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) calendar days after its passage by the Council.
