FOR THE PURPOSE of selecting a preferred alternative design for the Youth and Community Wing project

WHEREAS, the Council has identified a need for additional space to serve the youth and community members of Riverdale Park; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that a renovated Town Hall building would serve as the best location for additional community space; and

WHEREAS, the Council established a project in the Capital Improvement Program budget called the Youth and Community Wing project; and

WHEREAS, the Town has retained Paul Mortensen Architects to design this project; and

WHEREAS, Paul Mortensen Architects worked with members of Town staff, Council, and the public to create design principles for the project; and

WHEREAS, Paul Mortensen Architects created two design alternatives for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a series of public meetings to discuss the design principles and the designs

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK that the Council selects the two-story design as its preferred design alternative for the Youth and Community Wing project.
