Resolution of the Town of Riverdale Park to designate Riverdale as a Sustainable Community, pursuant to the attached Sustainable Community map and Sustainable Community Plan, herein referred to as the "Plan," as further described in the Sustainable Community Application ("the Application,") for approval either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through the Smart Growth Subcabinet of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverdale Park recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Riverdale Park; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverdale Park proposes to (i) designate the area of Riverdale Park in Prince George's County as part of the Greater Riverdale Sustainable Community application, as outlined on the attached map ("the Area,") as a Sustainable Community, and to (ii) adopt the Plan, as further described in the Application, for the purposes of contributing to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act; and

WHEREAS, the Community Legacy program regulations require a local government to submit an application to the Department in order to become a designated Sustainable Community, and to adopt a satisfactory Sustainable Community Plan in order to be eligible to receive financial assistance under the Community Legacy Program;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Riverdale Park hereby (i) endorses the designation of the Area as a Sustainable Community; and (ii) adopts the Sustainable Community Plan described in the Application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Town Administrator Sara Imhulse is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of these resolutions; and,


